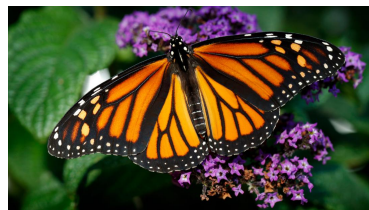
Welcome to the March/April issue of our newsletter, packed with lots of exciting news!
